

Mt St Michel

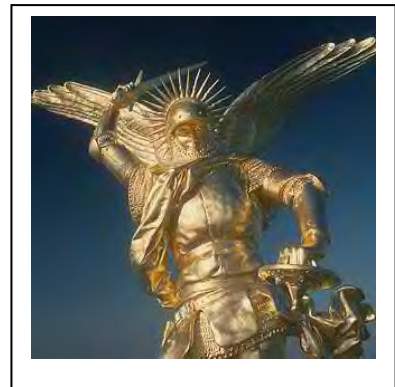


Mt St Michel is the 2nd most visited place in France outside of Paris and so it is best to get there before dinner time. It was created Bishop Aubert Mont St Michel was created after the Archangel Michael appeared to Bishop Aubert and told him to build a sanctuary.

Not an easy task to build on a granite rock that is surrounded by the sea when the tide comes in but it was completed in 708.

Not only historically interesting but the view and architecture are breathtaking. You can reach it in just 90 mins from our bed and breakfast.

Mont Saint-Michel then became one of the major pilgrimage destinations in medieval Christendom. A magnificent Abbey was built by the Monks of the Benedictines In 966. A Romanesque monastery was built in the 11th and 12th centuries.
